- To apply for this scholarship you must be a child of a member; or a child of a member's employee; or a child of an employee of Vet Services HB Ltd.
- The member is defined as person or operating entity.
- The said member must have been a member of CHBFVC for a minimum period of 12 months prior to the closing date of the scholarship being offered, or at the discretion of the CHBFVC executive.
- The employees of Vet Services HB Ltd must have been an employee for a minimum period of 12 months prior to the closing date of the scholarship being offered, or at the discretion of the CHBFVC executive.
- Must be currently enrolled at a Secondary School.
- Applicants will need to study Veterinary Science (BVSc.).
- Applicants will be formally interviewed by a 'Selection Committee'.
- At the sole discretion of the 'Selection Committee' two Scholarships may be awarded annually.
- A successful applicant will be awarded \$10,000.00 over 5 years for a BVSc. degree.

6. FURTHER TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP

- The successful applicant is paid \$1,000.00 upon submission of entry papers to the 'pre-selection semester' of Massey Vet School.
- The Scholar is paid a further \$1,000.00 post successful exam results from the 1st semester and acceptance of entry to the 'professional stage' of the BVSc. Degree.
- The Scholar receives \$2,000.00 per annum for the remaining 4 years.
- These payments are conditional to successful exam results annually.

If the Scholar does not pass 1st semester papers and chooses to enter another Degree with the intent of re-entering the Massey Vet School at a later date, he/she must:

- Provide proof of entry to another approved tertiary education course.
- Provide proof of successful exam results and acceptance of entry to the 'professional stage' of the BVSc. Degree. Therefore the original scholarship will continue and the scholar will be paid the second \$1,000.00.
- The Scholar receives \$2,000.00 per annum for the remaining 4 years
- These payments are conditional to successful exam results annually
- If this is not the case after 5 years from the date of being awarded the scholarship-any remaining scholarship payment will be regarded as lapsed.
